### **GENERAL GUIDELINES\***

**Closing Date** October 31, 2023- late entries will not be considered. 2. **Format** Typed (size 12 font double spaced) or neatly handwritten on one side of the A4 page only. Pages should be numbered on the bottom right hand corner. The top of the page should include: Title of Story Student name / Group Name and School Do not staple, laminate or bind your entry. 3. Length Submissions must remain within the following length restraints: No work should exceed 1500 words 4. **Authors** The written work must be the sole creation of the individual or group of writers/poets. 5. **Supervision** Only constructive criticism and general guidance is to be provided by any supervisor/ 6. Theme parent/teacher... "Student Choice" **7. Judging** Submissions will be judged on originality and content of the text. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. 8. **Judges** The panel of judges selected will include professionals in the fields of education and literature. 9. **Entry From** Submissions will not be considered if they are not accompanied by a completed Entry Form. Multiply Entry Forms are to be completed and attached to the submission for each member of any group. 10. **Declaration** Students must sign the Declaration for their entry to be considered for the competition. And this must be supported by a declaration from the classroom teacher 11. Parent/Guardian All Entry Forms must be signed by a Parent/Guardian for participants. 12. **Return of Entries** Entries will not be returned unless a request is made at the time of submission and includes a stamped, addressed envelope. 13. **Aboriginality** Entry to this competition is only open to students of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent. Entry to the Group Completion requires at least three writers one of whom must be Aboriginal (the whole class can enter a group piece provided at least one of the students is Aboriginal) 14. Winners Prize winners will be notified by mail and their creative works may be published on the NSW AEC website. **15. Prizes** Prizes from \$50.00 up to \$500 and Encouragement Awards from \$20 up to \$250 will be awarded to students from Kindergarten to Year 12 for Poetry and Short Story or Play.

Prizes of up to \$250 will be awarded for Kindergarten - Year 1 and Year 2-3 Group work
